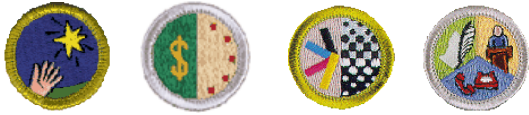

## MERIT BADGE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

Merit Badge Partners have the opportunity to provide direct training to youth through Merit Badge clinics, workshops, facility tours, and merit badge counselors, which will foster experiences that may be available in no other way. Your Partnership can literally change the life of a Scout.

The Boy Scout Merit Badge Program introduces youth to the principles of citizenship, potential careers, new hobbies and sports, and a wide variety of life skills. Merit Badges play an important role in fulfilling the BSA Mission; "...to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices, by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law."

The Merit Badge Partnership Program strengthens the bonds between the community and Scouting by offering opportunities for organizations and businesses to provide financial support to Scouting locally. Partnering organizations forge this partnership by choosing Merit Badges that align with their business expertise and mission.

*There are 137 total Merit Badges available to Scouts. To rise to the highest rank of Eagle, a Scout must earn 21 Merit Badges, 13 of which are specifically required. The other 8 may be chosen from the list of offered elective Merit Badges.*

### HOW THE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM WORKS

Several annual partnership options are available:

**Elective Merit Badge (\$500 per badge).** Businesses/ organizations may sponsor elective Merit Badges at this level.

**Premier Elective Merit Badge (\$1,000 per badge).** Sponsoring businesses/organizations receive additional benefits at this level.

**Eagle Merit Badge (\$1,000 per badge).** Businesses/ organizations may sponsor Eagle required Merit Badges at this level.

**Premier Eagle Merit Badge (\$2,000 per badge).** Sponsoring businesses/organizations receive additional benefits at this level.

**Individual Merit Badge Booster (\$100 per badge).** Any individual or family may become a booster.
