



Wood Badge/NYLT Staff Interest Form

NATIONAL COURSE STAFF

This form provides a way for a Scouter, who fulfills the eligibility requirements, to indicate their interest in the staffing opportunity. Adult Volunteers registered in Cub Scouting, Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouts, District, or Council levels, are encouraged to express interest in serving.

Because this form is not an application, it will not receive an immediate response. Course Directors as part of their staff selection process may contact you for a position. Please note that we are interested in diverse representation of the council and at least 33% percent of staffers will be serving for the first time.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To serve on a staff, a Scouter must:

- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America and a strong supporter of the local council.
- Have completed a Wood Badge for the 21st Century course and received the Wood Badge beads before the start of the course they will staff. *
- Be enthusiastic, open-minded, flexible, people-oriented, and committed to implementing the course in a positive manner.
- Be a role model who is well-respected by volunteers and professionals.
- Exemplify the Scout Oath, the Scout Law.
- Demonstrate the ability to train, to counsel, and to perform the specific skills, duties, and responsibilities of an assigned position.
- Have successfully completed the Trainer's EDGE course.
- Be approved by the Council Training Chair, Scout Executive and Area 4 Training Chair.

*Individuals who served on the staff of a NYLT or Wood Badge for the 21st Century course in a required staff position before December 31, 2019, are exempt from this qualification.

A Course Director may serve on the staff of a subsequent course in either a required or optional support staff position (including mentor to the course director) only after their initial term of service is complete and their final follow-up report has been submitted.

PROCEDURE

1. Review and complete the Staff Interest Form.
2. Email the completed form to training@vccbsa.org or submit forms to the Council Office
3. Forms are considered and evaluated according to the current Administrative Guide
